



## **ADMISSION POLICIES**

The conditions for a student's acceptance to Zion Christian Academy includes an interview, former records, and a placement test (at the discretion of the principal). Students will be reviewed annually and will be allowed to enroll based on academic progress and discipline records. Our intent is to partner with parents to develop strong Godly character in their children and to develop the next generation of world changers and Christian leaders.

Registration of a student will be finalized when the following items have been satisfactorily completed:

- A personal interview/tour with of parents and prospective students with school administration.
- Application/registration form completed and signed by parents or guardians.
- Application/registration fee paid.
- Student's health and other record forms completed.
- Family/Student Handbook and Code of Conduct signed by parents or guardians.
- Entrance/placement test satisfactorily completed. (at the discretion of the principal)
- Student's acceptance by the admissions board.

\*Zion Christian Academy complies with Kentucky State Law concerning age requirements for Kindergarten and First Grade.

\*Zion Christian Academy is limited in the acceptance of hyperactive or hyperkinetic children.

\*ZCA does not offer support services via a school counselor, psychologist, or special education teacher for challenging social, emotional, or behavioral issues leading to conduct which interferes with learning in a regular classroom environment.
